Love will end abortion. This is the simple motto of The Station of the Cross's pro-life outreach: Warriors of Love. We began in June 2008 with the simple mission to bring love to the front door of 2500 Main Street (the most active child-killing center in Buffalo) through public prayer and Christian witness.

A DAY AT THE CLINIC:

- 7:00 AM Jim Havens and myself arrive.
- 7:15 AM The Warriors of Love banner is raised, reading 16 feet across: Love will end abortion.
- 7:30 AM Most of the prayer warriors have arrived. We begin to pray the Joyful mysteries of the Rosary.
- 7:45 AM The clinic opens. We continue praying for the women scheduled to have abortions as well as for the abortionist and her staff.
- 9:00 AM After praying through all the mysteries of the Rosary, as well as singing a Chaplet of Divine Mercy, our time spent in front of the clinic has ended but the graces bestowed on the clinic as well as the participants remain.

WHY NOT JOIN US?

Warriors of Love puts into action the most basic principle of our common Christian vocation: love. This vocation is not reserved for a select few but rather the entirety of the Church, fulfilling what it means to be Christian by living in and through Christ's love for us. As Pope St. Gregory the Great recited, "The proof of love is in the works. Where love exists, it works great things. But when it ceases to act, it ceases to exist."
